Dear Parents/Guardians,

In light of the current COVID-19 situation, we have made the decision to ensure students have an online platform to connect with our school and their teachers. If you haven't already done so, please ensure that you have downloaded our school app "Skoolbag". This is to ensure that our communication with you is easier, quicker and more efficient as we will be using this app to provide students with school work.

The *Skoolbag: School Communication* app allows us to keep you all updated with school information, news, calendar events and contact information.

If you have a smartphone (Android or iPhone) you can download Skoolbag: School Communication App from Google Play Android or the Apple Store for FREE. Access is also available on a tablet and iPad by following the same downloading process.

When we update the Marayong South Public School's Skoolbag: School Communication app with new information or news about the school, a push message notification will automatically be sent to your device to inform you of this update. You can then view the notification which will then take you directly to our app.

Instructions for download SkoolBag:

1. Using your device (iPad, iPhone, smart pad, tablet or android phone), visit the relevant marketplace for your product (Apple Store or Google Play).



2. Search for Skoolbag: School Communication and download the app.

- 3. Once downloaded, open the app. Here you will need to open an account with Skoolbag using an email address and a secure password, a confirmation email will be sent to the email address you used for further security checks.
- 4. Once you have created an account, open the app.
- 5. Tap on 'Add/Remove' circle and use the search bar within the app and enter the name our school: *Marayong South Public School*.
- 6. Tap the search button.
- 7. Once you see the school name/logo displayed, tap the '+' sign next to it:





Instructions on using the app Skoolbag:

- 1. On the home page, tap the Marayong South Public School's logo to enter the school.
- 2. In the *General* tab
 - a. Notices where all news and updates are sent here
 - b. Upcoming Events
 - c. Current What's On 2020
 - d. Parent Handbook 2020
 - e. DEC NSW News feed
- 3. In the *Groups* tab
 - *a.* Parents can add groups of interest (Kindergarten to Year 6) to be sent relevant information for their child's stage group.
